## Trent/Brock/McMaster All departments

This exchange program with three Ontario universities is separate from the Baden-Württemberg - Ontario exchange program. Up to 30 students from either country can participate in the exchange program, as did in 1994.

Access is limited to undergraduate students. Students from the Departments of Medicine and Law are usually excluded. The program is also open to faculty members. Students are expected to have at least second year standing (i.e. "Vordiplom" or "Zwischenprüfung"). Applicants in Germany are screened and selected by a committee of representatives from the "Akademisches Auslandsamt", the English Department and the Canadian Resident Director for the exchange program at Freiburg.

The program includes a reduced tuition waiver (ancillary fee of CDN \$ 2500). German students that are not on the BAFöG scheme may apply for a supportive grant for their travel costs from the Land of Baden-Württemberg.

Students are admitted as non-degree students at the host institution, i.e. they can attend courses and acquire credits ("Scheine") at the partner university, which may be accepted by their home university, but they cannot receive an academic degree at the host university.

Students remain enrolled at their home university, German students usually receive special leave status.
