

ARTICLE 24

Registration with the International Civil Aviation Organization

This Agreement and any amendment shall be registered with the International Civil Aviation Organization.

ARTICLE 25

Multilateral Conventions

1. If a multilateral convention comes into force in respect of both Contracting Parties, consultations may be held in accordance with Article 20 (Consultations) with a view to determining the extent to which this Agreement is affected by the provisions of the multilateral convention.
2. Without limiting the generality of their rights and obligations under international law, the Contracting Parties shall act in conformity with the provisions of the Convention.

ARTICLE 26

Entry into Force

This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of the last written notification, through diplomatic channels, by which the Contracting Parties have notified each other that all necessary internal procedures for entry into force of this Agreement have been completed.

The *Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of Jamaica on Air Transport*, done on 18 October 1985, as amended on 16 December 1987, terminates upon entry into force of this Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, duly authorized thereto by their respective Governments, have signed this Agreement.
