## PRAYERS

Mr. Béchar, from the Standing Committee on Fisheries and Forestry, presented the Third Report of the Committee, which is as follows:

While considering the Estimates of the Department of the Environment for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1976, your Committee agreed to report the following to the House:

Your Committee recommends that the Annual Report of the Department of the Environment for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1974, which was tabled in the House on January 22, 1975, be referred to this Committee for study.

Mr. Béchar, from the Standing Committee on Fisheries and Forestry, presented the Fourth Report of the Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Monday, February 24, 1975, your Committee has considered Votes 1, 5, 10, 15, L20, 25, 30 and 35 under Environment in the Estimates for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1976, and reports the same.

A copy of the relevant Minutes of Proceedings and Evidence (*Issues Nos. 5, 6, 10 to 15, 17 and 28 to 34*) is tabled.

The following Bill from the Senate was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House:

Bill S-25, An Act to amend the Privileges and Immunities (International Organizations) Act.—*Mr. MacEachen.*

The following Notice of Motion having been called was transferred to Government Orders for consideration at the next sitting of the House pursuant to Standing Order 21(2):

That a Special Joint Committee of the Senate and House of Commons be appointed to review and report upon matters bearing upon the development of the National Capital Region, including the programs and operations of the National Capital Commission;

That 15 Members of the House of Commons to be designated by the House at a later date be the members on the part of this House of the Special Joint Committee;
