Agriculture and Forestry (n) The Senate Committee on Agriculture and Forestry, composed of twelve members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum, to which shall be referred, on order of the Senate, bills, messages, petitions, inquiries, papers and other matters relating to agriculture and forestry generally, and the Canadian Wheat Board.

Fisheries

(n.1) The Senate Committee on Fisheries, composed of twelve members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum, to which shall be referred, on order of the Senate, bills, messages, petitions, inquiries, papers and other matters relating to fisheries generally.

Energy and Natural Resources

- (o) The Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources, composed of twelve members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum, to which shall be referred, on order of the Senate, bills, messages, petitions, inquiries, papers and other matters relating to energy and natural resources generally, including:
 - (i) natural resources, other than fisheries and forestry, and mines;
 - (ii) pipelines, transmission lines and energy transportation;
 - (iii) environmental affairs;
 - (iv) other energy-related matters.

Aboriginal Peoples (p) The Standing Committee on Aboriginal Peoples, composed of twelve members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum, to which may be referred, as the Senate may decide, bills, messages, petitions, inquiries, papers and other matters relating to the Aboriginal Peoples of Canada.

Residual matters

- (2) Any bill, message, petition, inquiry, paper or other matter may be referred, as the Senate may decide, to any Committee.
- (3) A legislative committee shall be composed of not more than twelve members.
