or a member of any Standing Committee absent from three consecutive meetings of his Committee, without giving satisfactory reason for such absence, the office shall be declared vacant.

LAW XXII.

DISCIPLINE.

In case of misconduct of any member, or neglect of duty of an officer, a majority of the League present at the first regular meeting of any month, may declare the office of such offender vacant, reprove or expel such member. A violation of the total abstinence pledge of this League shall be considered a gross case of misconduct.

LAW XXIII.

CHANGE OF RESIDENCE.

It shall be the duty of each member to notify the Secretary of any change in his address, as notices issued by this League to the address which appears on the roll book shall be valid notice.
