Important Montreal Men Will Equip Hundred and Twenty-Five Men.

DUKE WILL VISIT CAMP

Thirty-One Thousand Men Will Be Reviewed on Sunday.

A Staff Reporter. OTTAWA, Sept. 2.—Colonel Sam Hughes announced this afternoon that number of Montreal men had offered to equip a motorcycle corps of 125 men to go with the Canadian contingent and the offer has been accepted.

The Duke of Connaught will visit alcazar camp next week-end, as will also Sir Robert Borden and many other members of the cabinet. There will be some 31,000 troops in camp, and the first public review will be held on Sunday afternoon.
