uing; Gloves and mittens; Harness and saddlery; Jewellery and repairs; Latets and pegs; Matches; Mattresses and spring beds; Monuments and tombestone; Picture frame; Printing publishing; Tobacco chewing, smoking and snuff; Tobacco cigar and cigarettes; Silversmiting; Washing compound; Vinegar pickles; Woodworking and turning; Wollen goods; Fringes, bords and tessels; Blacking; Corks; Jewelry cases; Leather goods; Flax dressed.

Whereas the Municipal Council of the town of Nicolet, at its meeting of the 9th of december 1909, has adopted a resolution by which an exemption of taxes for 20 years is offered to all persons or Companies which will start a manufacture or

a new industry, of any kind.

In consequence, the Board of Trade of the District of Nicolet approves the attitude of the municipal Council and autorizes the president and the secretary of this board to see that the present resolution be printed in french and in english and that copies distributed to business men to whom they think advisable.
