Porcupine Still Advancing Market Strong and Active

Good Day's Trading on Mining Exchanges---Hollinger Drops on Outside Selling---Sillers Steady With Some Gains

World Office, Thursday Evening, Aug. 17. The Porcupines are still on the ascent. The market to-day opened strong and maintained its good condition throughout the day, although there were the usual fluctuations in prices. The advance was not merely so marked as the day previous, but the upward movement was still quite marked. The covering by shorts and renewed public interest were responsible for the gains. The amount of trading done was the largest for some time. By noon the market was sailing upwards at a great rate, but early in the afternoon came news of New York selling of Hollinger for London interests, and this stock started down, getting below ten dollars, one sale being made at 9.85, Hollinger high for the day was 10.22, and its weakness had a small effect upon the rest of the list, but generally the market held firm, with some gains. Dome Extension went up to 56, closing at 54. Preston East Dome made a good advance from 25 1/2 to 28 at the close. Rea gained 2 points on a day's trading, closing at 2.30, and Vipond moved up to 45 1/2, closing a little below this figure. Coronation skyrocketed up from 19 to 23. The Cobalts retained their firmness, although there were few sales in the silver shares. Beaver climbed to 47, but dropped back to 46 1/4 at the close. Timiskaming made a half point. Gould was a fraction higher, and there was some buying in Great-Mechan. Another strong market is looked for to-morrow, with further small advances.

ANTICS OF APEX. A flamboyant advertisement over Apex at 10 cents a share was ridiculed in Toronto mining circles yesterday. Offers were made on two exchanges for 25,000 shares of Apex 60 days' delivery at 12 1/2 cents, without execution. For the stock immediate delivery 12 1/2 cents was bid at the close. The Montreal offering at 10 cents has a string to it, or the broker should get in touch with buyers.

ANOTHER ST. ANTHONY STRIKE. They have struck another lead on the St. Anthony mine, Sturgeon Lake. Word was received yesterday that at the 100 foot level, an offshoot of the main vein was traced into the shaft wall for 20 feet. At the start this vein was 18 inches wide, but widening to 3 1/2 feet. An ore body assaying from \$1000 a ton to \$2000 a ton was discovered.

MOVEMENT UPWARD IN WHEAT MARKET. Prices Advance One Cent on Sold Out Market---Brokers' Comment. Erlanson Perkins & Co. had the following: Wheat---Market opened strong and ruled firm with offerings light and had a solid appearance. We do not hear of very much cash business to-day, although a sale of 50,000 No. 2 hard was reported at 100 over Sept. c.f. Buffalo. Southwest markets were higher for cash wheats with a good demand. Northwest markets were strong, showing returns from the spring wheat country are beginning to show very poor yields. We feel that prices are on a comparatively safe basis, and that from now till the demand will be sufficient to take care of the prospective movement and advise purchases on all weak spots. Corn---Market ruled very dull with a strong undertone. There seems to be very little selling pressure. Cash demand was fair and receipts moderate. Kansas receipts 54,000 to 55,000 last to the east were of fair volume. We look for a gradual hardening of values. Oats---Market continued to rule very strong with light trade. Primary movement of 1,500,000 bushels last year, showing a decided disposition on the part of the farmers to hold.

MONTREAL SHIPPING SUFFERS FROM STRIKE

Ocean Trade Seriously Hampered---Waterfront Sheds Jammed With Unshippable Cargo.

MONTREAL, Aug. 17---An immediate local effect of the serious dock strike in Liverpool and other British ports is the refusal of Montreal bankers to make advances on bills of lading. The matter which threatens to seriously hamper ocean trade. It is also reported here that some of the marine insurance companies have declined to write policies on perishable cargoes bound for affected ports, while such as have been issued have been at an advanced premium. The Canadian Pacific Railway had no news at its Montreal offices to-day regarding the Lake Champlain, which is due to steam from Liverpool during the day, but it is believed that her sailing will certainly be delayed, and it is thought that she will return to Montreal with a portion of the cargo she carried from this port. The Allan Line steamer has reached here from London with a light manifest. It was given out to-day that she will coal here for her return voyage.

Dock hands, importers, exporters and shipping companies alike are all suffering from the effects of the strike, and if matters are not straightened out very shortly there threatens to be a general tie-up in the Liverpool service. The Liverpool agents of practically all shipping companies are crowded with goods waiting to be shipped. Other cargo is being stored at the wharves by the shippers who have issued orders to hold their cargoes until the strike has been settled.

YOUTH GOES TO "PEN". Sentenced to Two Years for Breaking Into Cars. MONTREAL, Aug. 17---Gordon McMartin, a youth of 16, was sent to the penitentiary for breaking into cars at Lake of Woods. He was sentenced to two years for breaking into cars of the Grand Trunk Railway. Other charges hanging over him are for a theft of \$40 from Joseph Adelaar of Coteau Landing. He is also wanted in Belleville and St. Alban's for stealing clothes. At the time of his arrest the chief of police from St. Alban's was looking for him in this city on the latter charge.

Ozonizing the Tubes. The "tube" or subway in London are being "ozonized," as some of the metropolitan papers term it. An elaborate plant for the pumping of air into the underground tunnels has been installed. An official of the Central London Tube Railway says: "The plant at each station will pump 40,000 cubic feet of air an hour into the tunnel, or at the rate of 900 cubic feet a person an hour. The ordinary allowance in buildings is about 200 cubic feet of fresh air a person. The air is drawn from outside thru a filter screen, which removes dust and dirt and impure gases, such as ammonia and sulphurous acid. A part of the air is then highly ozonized by being passed over highly electrified plates, the proportion of ozone in the whole being one part in 10,000,000. The air is driven by fans to the level of the bottom of the station, and two-thirds of it is distributed over the platform by ducts, with outlets at a height of seven feet above the platform. The remainder is driven into the tunnel."

House of Commons Tea Parties. Tea on the terrace has been so exceedingly popular in the hot weather we have had this summer that in the popular hours of the afternoon the tea-room staff of the house has been completely taken up to meet the demand. Large tea parties are a feature of every afternoon when the commons are sitting. Considering how completely tea on the terrace has become a feature of the life of London society in summer, it is worth remembering that it was a hot special such as we have recently experienced which really gave birth to the custom of entertaining ladies to tea at the commons.
