OUR NEEDS.

The estimates for 1892-93 are \$20,000.

We need Sunday Schools, Churches and individuals who will give Annual Scholarships of \$50.

Last year we said the Endowment should be raised speedily to \$100,000. Some of our friends think we ought to have a \$1,000,000, and we all quite readily agree to it.

The new wing and a Principal's residence are needed at Grande Ligne.

We need a church building of our own at Maskinongé. We have secured the ground.

We need the prayers of God's people and the power of the Holy Spirit, or our work will all be in vain.

NOTES.

Nearly every English speaking Protestant Church in the Province of Quebec, has more and more each year to contend with the influence of an ever increasing French population. If we are to reach them with the Gospel, it must be, as a rule, through their native tongue.

In no way can our English Churches become so aggressive, as through the instrumentality of English pastors who speak fluently the French language. If some of the churches are to live it must be by such a course.

Where are the English young men that we expected to devote their lives to this work with as great enthusiasm as do Foreign Missionaries. Surely the call is as great to learn the language of more than a million people who are ignorant of the pure Gospel,
