Ottawa, Jan. 9-With the issuing of Quebec's census figures today one may for the first time hazard a guess that the population of Canada as a whole will be in the neighborhood of 8,714,000. Details given by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics show that all Canada, excluding the provinces of Saskatchewan and British Columbia, has a population and British Columbia, has a population of 7,478,493. The population of the other two provinces is a matter of considerable speculation, and the result cannot be approximated with any degree of accuracy. It is a fact, however, that from 1911 to 1916 Saskatchewan's population increased from 492,432 to 647,835, an increase of thirty-one per cent.

"No one knows just how opals came




