It is interesting, in view of the revenue, to look back a little and note what revenue was received in 1916, the last year of the old government. In that year the auditor-general's report tells that the ordinary receipts were \$1,580,-419.36, which was made up, outside of the annual Dominion subsidy, very largely by territorial revenue—\$540,-386.06.

Last year the territorial revenue amounted to nearly three times that amount, being \$1,589,539, which in fact was \$9,000 more than the total receipts of 1916.

It is interesting in this connection to show the way in which the revenue and expenditures were estimated and what differences there were in the estimates of the members of the government and the amounts received, as well as the difference between the amounts to be expended and the amounts actually expended. The statement below shows very clearly the difficulty there was owing to unsettled prevailing conditions in making a close estimate as to what the expenditure would be in any particular department.

For example, the territorial revenue exceeded the estimates by \$100,000. Cor-






