of the Primary Examination do not form part of the Examination allowed, the Candidate shall be required to take such subjects together with his Final Examination.

Graduates in Arts of any recognized University, shall not be required to take such subjects of the Primary Examination as they have already passed in their University Examination.

FINAL EXAMINATION IN DENTISTRY.

This Examination will be held at the end of the Final Year. The subjects are:

Operative Dentistry, Oral and Dental Pathology, Dental Anatomy, Dental Therapeutics, Prosthetic Dentistry, Physiology, Histology, Chemistry, and Materia Medica.

Students will be required to produce satisfactory evidence of proficiency in Practical Dentistry. The certificate of the Royal College of Dental Surgeons will be accepted.

The Primary and Final Examination may be taken together at the end of the Final Year.

The Primary and Final Examinations in 1894 will begin on March 12th.

Notice must be sent to the Registrar on a form which will be furnished, together with the fee for registration, examination, and degree, by March 1st.
