PASSED AWAY TODAY

Was One of St. John's Leading Merchants Thirty Years Ago—County Treasurer Twenty One Years.

Mr. J. S. Boris deVeber died about noon today at his home, 137 Leinster street, after an illness of some six noon today at his home, 187 Leinster street, after an illness of some six weeks, death being due to general breakup. Mr. deVeber, who was in his 79th year, was one of St. John's best known citizens. He was of Loyalist descent, being a son of Leverett H. deVeber, who in turn was a son of Gabriel deVeber, an officer of the crown against the American revolutionists. Mr. Boris deVeber was born in St. John and educated here. After the death of his father he was for some time one of the leading dry goods merchants of the city. Mr. deVeber and his brother Richard having taken over the business. After the fire they put up the large brick blook on Prince William street, now occupied by the Dearborn Company. During a period of severe depression in which many business houses went under the deVeber concern met with serious losses and was forced to suspend. Twenty-one years ago Mr. deVeber was appointed County Treasurer which position he has since held. He served for a term in Federal Parliament as representative for St. John, under Mackenzie.

Mr. deVeber was a life long member of St. Paul's Church and was prominent socially. He is survived by his
