

The plckets had absolutely no chance to get at the men and could not dissuade them from go-ing to work. There are in all about 120 strike breakers in the yard now. The men are being housed in temporary living quarters in the yards. The com-pany has a force of Pinkerton men in the yards now, it is said, and has al-most doubled its special constables staff. The union men have made no demonstration. 
