SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST MINING REGULATIONS.

COAL.—Coal mining rights may be leased for twenty-one years, renewable at an annual rental of \$1 an acre. Not more than 2,560 acres can be leased to one applicant. Royalty, five cents per ton.
