

REPORT

OF THE

COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT.

The Committee of Management beg to submit the thirty-fifth Annual Report of the proceedings of your Society.

During the past year your Society has provided seasonable and substantial aid in eighty cases of distress, comprising one hundred and twenty-nine individuals; of these seventeen have been sent home to England, fifty one have been assisted to enable them to proceed to Ontario and the West, and five to the Lower Ports, whilst fifty-five were relieved locally.

The expenditure for charitable purposes amounts to six hundred and forty-two dollars 10 cents, (\$642.10.)

The Society continues to be indebted to James A. Sewell, Esq., M.D., for his valuable services as physician and as member of the Charitable Committee.

The Treasurer's account which accompanies this report shows that the financial affairs of the Society are in a sound and prosperous state.

We have added to our list of members nine names; one honorary, seven ordinary, and one life member,—Mr. H. J. Pratten.
