

The river is continuing to rise. The road on the Breslau side of the river is flooded, the people crossing in barges. ANOTHER URGES GREATER HATRED OF ERIN FOR ENGLAND.

LONDON, March 17.—A Sinn Fein demonstration was held in Skibbereen to-day, it welcoming Pender, a Sinn Fein member of Parliament, who was just released from jail. Pender declared: "The

Irish are at war with England, and that they mean to finish the struggle."

Bernie O'Driscoll declared the Germans would be welcomed to Ireland if they drove out the English. Sean Hayes, M.P., said he hoped Irish hatred of England will be intensified.

Secretary of Commerce Redfield is scheduled to speak in Chicago to-night in behalf of the League of Nations.
