Together With 172 Other Prisoners.

28 last, in the courtyard of Deriabinsk Prison, in a suburb of Petrograd," a Helsingfors despatch to the Times states, "together with the grand Dukes 172 other persons were shot, 144 men and 28 women, who were accused by the Bolshevists of having taken part in the so-called Angio-French organizations." A reliable report from Petrograd states that all four grand dukes died with dignity.

Grand Duke Nicholas Alikhailovitch, being ill and exhausted by starvation, had to be carried on a hand-barrow into the courtyard and in this position he was shot.

The execution was carried out in the early morning, with the mercury standing at 17 degrees below zero, by a detachment of sailors and Chinese, and in the presence of delegates of the Extraordinary Commission.

Dr. David's speech was little more than a repetition of the words of Chancellor Ebert on Tuesday, especially when he referred to Assace-Lorraine and the union of Austria with dermany, both of these references bein loudly cheered.

Germany, he said, could earn the contidence of this world only by rapid creative work and must understand now to bridge the gulf to co-operative understandings. His greeting to Alsace-Lorraine and the declaration that Germany would not stop insisting that it have the right of self-determination evoked a great ovation, as did his reference to the Austrians, whom he said, he hoped to be able to welcome as colleagues.
