I have now the honor to bid you farewell, with those serious thoughts which the word farewell naturally awakens, with every acknowledgement of the many courtesies and the effective assistance which I have received at your hands, and with the most cherished and ardent wishes for the welfare of the Dominion with which I rejoice to think that my humble name has been connected by an honourable tie for more than three years.

Then the Honorable the Speaker of the Senate said :-

Honorable Gentlemen of the Senate, Gentlemen of the House of Commons:—

It is His Excellency the Governor General's will and pleasure that this Parliament be prorogued until Wednesday, the Twenty- fourth day of July next, to be then here holden, and this Parliament is accordingly prorogued until Wednesday, the Twenty-fourth day of July next.
