

21. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Three thousand five hundred dollars be granted to Her Majesty, to defray expenses in connection with *Etang du Nord*, *Magdalen Island*, *Quebec*, for the year ending 30th June, 1882.

22. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Seven thousand five hundred dollars be granted to Her Majesty, to defray expenses in connection with *Owen Sound Harbor*, *Ontario*, to complete works, for the year ending 30th June, 1882.

23. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Nine thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, to defray expenses in connection with Dredging in the Maritime Provinces, new hull, &c., for dredge vessel, for the year ending 30th June, 1882.

24. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding One thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, to defray expenses in connection with Union Suspension Bridge, *Ottawa*, additional amount required, for the year ending 30th June, 1882.

25. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Two hundred and thirty-three dollars and eighty cents be granted to Her Majesty, to pay *D. Fraser* in full and final settlement of his claim (revote), for the year ending 30th June, 1882.
