Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th instant asking what arrangements were made respecting the two stores and the dwelling that were on the land recently purchased from the Canadian Pacific Railway Company adjoining the Brocket station grounds in the Peigan Indian Reserve. The Railway Company has not forwarded the deed for this land and until that has been done it is not intended to deal with the applications of Mr. Megginson and the Brocket Trading Company.
