account of such of the Indian Lands  
in that Township as were erroneously  
received as Clergy lands, the same to  
be charged as a part of the debt of the  
late Province of Canada.

I am further to request that you  
move His Honor to cause His Govern-  
ments to transfer to this Department  
for the benefit of the Indians, such  
of the said lands improperly received  
as remain unsold, and the collection  
of any uncollected purchase moneys  
owing upon such of them as have been  
sold, together with papers and copies of  
all accounts connected with the lands in  
question, as well as to pay over any  
purchase moneys which have been  
collected by His Honor's Government  
on account of the said lands.
