Referring to my letter of May 15th on this subject, your fyle 3-148.

I now enclose copy of a report received from Cpl. H.K. Blades dated at Churchill, May 17th, 1946 on this subject from which you will see that he is asking that the sum of \$3,850.00 be sent to him in \$1.00 bills.

Will you please note that Dr. Yule will be only able to accompany the Treaty Party to certain points, and that an additional doctor is asked for the trips to the Duck Lake and North River Bands.

Do you prefer to make the necessary arrangements for the plane service to York Factory, Shammattawa and Duck Lake or would you prefer for our Officer Commanding at Winnipeg to do so - chargeable to your Department?
