
I beg to inform you that the Tender of Messrs Wm. J. Pulling & Co., of Windsor, for Ties and Posts which the Indians of Shesheguaning Reserve purpose taking out during the present Winter has been accepted.

The price offered for Ties is 27-5/8 cents and for Posts 5 1/4 cents. The Ties to be of standard size, eight feet long by six inches face and six inches thick. The Posts to be eight feet long by five inches and upwards, diameter at small end.

The Company will pay an extra cent and three quarters, or 7 1/4 cents, if posts are peeled.

An agreement will be prepared and sent you for execution by the Indians.
