



I beg to inform you that the Department of Militia & Defence desires to secure the site on the Chillukweyuk Indian Reserve for a rifle range, and I inclose a copy of plan showing bordered in red the portion of land desired. You will be good enough to take this matter up with the Indians and report whether they are willing that permission should be given for the use of this land for the purpose desired, and on what terms and conditions.
