Ottawa, April 12, 1918.

Sir,-

I have your letter of the 8th instant, inclosing resolutions of the Kahkewistahaw, Sakimay and Cowessess bands in favour of expenditures from their funds on the purchase of heifers.

I am taking the necessary steps with a view to obtaining the sanction of Council for the expenditure of \$6000.00 from the Cowessess band capital and \$3000.00 from the Sakimay band capital, and upon the necessary Order in Council being passed you will be duly advised.

With regard to Kahkewistahaw, I find that this band has a sufficiently large interest account (\$29,559) to render it unnecessary to encroach upon their capital for the purchase of heifers to the extent of \$3000.00 and an Order in Council will not be necessary in connection therewith; that amount is therefore now available for the purchase of heifers for the Kahkewistahaw band.
