UPON reading what is filed in support of the complaint and on behalf of the Department of Finance of the Province of British Columbia-and upon the report and recommendation of an Engineer of the Search, concurred in by the Assistant Chief Engineer.

THE BOARD ORDERS that the view at the said crossing of the Canadian National Railways at the intersection of Tale Road and Water Street, at Hope, in the Province of British Columbia, be improved by removing the earth bank on the highway south of the proveing and on the west side of the road allowance, to an elevation not exceeding three foot above the grade of the highway, for a distance of 225 feet from the crossing, and that the brush be cleaned our and the trees trimmed to an elevation of 10 feet above the ground, as shown by eight lines on the plan on file with the Board under file No. 30215.2; that the shoulder of earth in the southeast angle of the crossing be lowered to an elevation three feet above the road, and the sight line established as shown in red on the plan filed, so as to give a view from a point on the highway 200 feet from the crossing of trains approaching from the east 200 feet from the grossing; that the earth in the northwest angle of the crossing be removed
