SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

By Direction of the Commanding Officer this Summary of Evidence is taken on Oath.

FIRST WITNESS FOR THE PROSECUTION Lieut J. H. Galloway, Canadian Infantry Corps, Acting Assistant Records Officer, 3 Canadian Infantry Reinforcement Unit, having been duly sworn, states:

I am Lieut J. H. Galloway, Canadian Infantry Corps, employed as Acting Assistant Records Officer, 3 Canadian Infantry Reinforcement Unit. I produce certified true extract of Part II Daily Order Number 115 dated the 18th day of May 1944 showing the accused, whom I now recognize, as being absent without leave from 0600 hours the 17th day of May 1944. This document purporting to be signed by Capt W. E. Thorne for Capt Thomas B. Rogers, Capt & Adjt 3 Cdn Inf Rgt Unit is marked Exhibit "A".
