I have recently had an inquiry from one of our Superintendents concerning the payment of Income Tax by an Indian employed as a teacher on an Indian Reserve. If you could tell me the policy with regard to the Indian teachers employed on the Six Nations Reserve it would clarify this matter.

I shall be seeing Mr. Frederickson next Saturday morning and if he is agreeable to your suggestion I shall probably have to approach the Province so that he may secure permission to make the survey over on Vancouver Island.

I certainly enjoyed my visit to Ottawa and it has given me a better appreciation of the problems which are experienced by the officials in Ottawa. I found my visits to the different schools most interesting. I was a little disappointed in the Boys' School at Spanish but was greatly impressed with the work being done at Lebet.
