Viarthum Flat - on the Left Bank of the Fraser
River about 7 miles above Lytton

■ 50 inches of water from the two small
creeks at the Northern end of the Reserve
Reserve - on the Right Banks of the Fraser River
about 8 miles below Fort George

■ The whole of the water from Fort Dallas
Creek is allotted for use on this Reserve.

Steed - palm - On the Right Banks of the Fraser River
about 30 miles above Lytton.

■ All the water in the stream on the North
West Boundary of the Reserve.
