Indians in common and -

* The right to all the water these Indians
may require for irrigation and other purposes
from Salmon River and from the two Creeks
flowing through the Reserve into the River
on the Western side of Salmon River, was
as far as the Commissioners had power declare
and given to them. (16 Aug 1877)

A Reserve on the Right Bank of the Thompson River
at the mouth of the Oregon Jack Creeks.

30 inches of water from Oregon Jack Creeks
or from any other available sources of water supply

Spindum Flat - on the Left Bank of the Fraser
River about 7 miles above Lytton

50 inches of water from the two small
creeks at the Northern end of the Reserve

Scab - on the Right Bank of the Fraser River
about 8 miles below Astor's Pass

The whole of the water from Hot Dallas
Creeks is allotted for use on this Reserve

Nechal-palm - On the Right Bank of the Fraser River
about 20 miles above Lytton

All the water on the stream on the North
West Boundary of the Reserve.
