

necessary attention to economy, cleanliness and good conduct.

3. They shall, at each monthly meeting of the Governors, report the state of the Hospital, and the state and the number of patients admitted and discharged during the preceding month.

4. They shall lay before the Governors, at every meeting, the book containing the minutes of their proceedings.

CHAPTER III.

OF THE TREASURER.

1. The Treasurer shall give security, if required by the Governors, for the due accounting for and payment of the money which he shall from time to time receive for the use of the Hospital.

2. He shall have the custody of all bonds, title-deeds, documents, and other papers relating to the property of the Corporation.

3. He shall also receive all moneys belonging to the Corporation, and pay out the whole, or any part thereof, on receipt of a written order from the Committee of Management, but not otherwise.

4. He shall deliver to the Secretary, three days at least previous to the General Annual Meeting, in each and every year, a full statement of all his accounts, with the vouchers, for the preceding year, to be laid before the said meeting.
