

RIFLE SHOOTING.

9. With reference to the resolution of the Council of the B. C. B. G. A. (passed 2nd of June, 1890) to the effect that no Militiamen should be deemed "efficient" so as to entitle such Militiamen to shoot at the Provincial Rifle Association Matches for the Militia Aggregates, or for a place on the Ottawa Team, unless such Militiamen has attended and performed a certain number of drills with his corps, between the 1st of January of any year and the opening day of the Provincial Association's annual meeting in the same year. Officers commanding Companies are only to give certificates of efficiency to N. C. O. and men who have attended and performed at least twelve regular parades of the B. C. B. G. A. between the 1st January and the day of the opening of the Provincial Rifle Association meeting in the same year.
