# RIVERVIEW HERD OF HOLSTEINS

"Last winter I bought a two-year-old daughter of Mr. Gordon Manhard's of our 20th, sire of the world's champion. This animal has an 18-lb. record. I bought her and her heifer calf, by the noted bull, Merit test, for \$1,000. Both animals are doing well with me."  
"Riverview Selma Ruby, the calf that was dropped by the heifer's calf to the bull King Selma, made a record of 18.37 lbs. as a two year old and 23.32 lbs. as a three year old. This latter record was made in the month of May, three years and three months old, and when she had been dry for only two weeks."  
"This record makes me think the hot weather last May. This heifer is such a persistent milk I have found it difficult to keep her in flesh."  
Bull  
Mr. Salley believes that too much care can not be exercised in the selection of a herd bull. "I have," said Mr. Salley, "are starting dead wrong because they are contenting themselves with cheap bulls, and they are not offering a bull as a present from any one, if I had to use him on my herd."  
Last April Mr. Salley purchased at the Belleville cattle sale a number of the individuals from the herd of Mr. Brethen, of Norwood. These included a

fine aged cow, Trintonia Mercedes Queen, for which we paid \$250. She has since given 2,94 lbs. of butter in 7 days freshening after the sale. She has averaged 78 lbs. of milk for 7 days.
