Ordered, That the Bill from the Legislative Council, intituled "An Act respecting "the application to Cities of certain provisions of the Assessment Act applicable also to "Counties," be now read the first time.

The Bill was accordingly read the first time; and ordered to be read a second time, on

Tuesday next.
