

A TEMPERANCE UNION.

Members Limited to Fourteen Drinks of Liquor Daily. "Signing the pledge" is no new thing, as is proved by researches in Italy. Interesting particulars of what would appear to be the earliest examples of written pledges to abstain from gam-ling and excessive drinking are given in the Turin Studi Medievali by Signor Girolamo Biscaro, who has discovered three such documents in the archives of Milan. The first of these records is an oath sworn on the gospels by Gia-como Pasquali and Armanino Duca to the effect that for two years they to the effect that for two years they will abstain from gambling in Pavia or within three miles thereof and will likewise retrain from inducing others to gamble on their behalf. The penalty for any breach of this oath is fixed at 5 sold! payable to Papio Bovatorio.

In the second document Perano de Bono promises Uberto de Proto to abstain from gambling for a certain period, exception being made on behalf of the game of bismentiro, at which however, he was not to lose haif of the game of bismentiro, at which, however, he was not to lose more than 2 denari on any one day. Further, he undertakes not to visit any ian for drinking purposes before the hour of vespers on Monday. A breach of either clause of the pledge involves the payment of 5 soldi to De Proto.
