LONDON, Thursday.-Every nation with interests in the Pacific-save England-seems to be doing something o safeguard and protect those interests. England alone rests upon what she has already done. If anything should arouse her, it is the fact that Germany is coing everything that she can do to secure her position and that of the United States, although a friendly power, is straining every nerve

to make up for lost time. The latest news from the States

confirms the announcement of some time ago, that the house of representatives committee on naval affairs had agreed to recommend the construction of two floating steel-built dry-docks capable of taking in 12,000 ton battleships; one for the Pacific coast and one the Atlantic coast, and also the establishment of a naval station, and arge gravel dock at Pearl Harbor, Honolulu-a place which should have

been a British coaling station and naval base had it not been for the almost criminal apathy of the administration of some years ago.

The Philippines, which occupy a central position with regard to Mritish possessions on three continents are to be kept in a most formidable state of defense at an early date. The defences of Manila are to be specially prepared with the view of the first place being the headquarters of the huge naval force which the United States intends to maintain there in

the future. Corregidor Island, which lies near

the entrance of the harbor and close to the northern shore, will be the chief defence against seaward attack, and will be provided with six batter-ies armed with long range ten-inch guns, whilst at the rear and to the south of Corregidor Islan 1 are other batteries will be constructed upon the
