## SILVER STRIKE IN THE YUKON

Dawson, R. T., April 19—An important new silver strike has been made at Keno Hill, arrivals from that promising field report. The new find is on Erickson Gulch, on the Croesus claim, and the vein averages three to six feet in width, with the ore yields assaying five hundred ounces to the ton on an average. As much as six thousand ounces have been taken from a ton of ore, the highest of any found on the hill.

The claim is near the foot of the hill, while the original claims are on top.

The Yukon Gold Company has shipped 3,300 tons of ore to Mayo Landing so far this winter and driven several hundred feet of new tunnel.
