Early in life he moved to Ontario, and for some years was a hardware merchant at Sudbury. He was elected, as a Conservative, to the Ontaria legislature for the district of East Nipissing in 1905. He was re-elected for the legislature in 1908 for Sudbury, and was appointed Minister of Lands, Forests and Mines in the Whitnev Cabinet. He was a member of the Royal Conservation Com mission in 1909, and vice-president of the Dominion Forestry Association. He was opposed to the Taft-Fielding reciprocity compact, and upon the defeat of the Laurier administration at the polls, in the general election of 1911, he accepted office in the Borden cabinet, as Minister of Railways and Canals. His administration of this portfolia is generally conceded to have been most highly successful.
