The Committee will prepare and keep on file a register of all men seeking employment, giving their age, qualifications and experience, so far as possible, of each applicant. This information will be available to prospective employers, and steps will be taken to bring about interviews or correspondence between employers and soldier or sailor applicants. Every person or firm when requiring such help for either domestic or business purposes is therefore invited to communicate to the Committee the nature of the help required, and of the work to be done, and such other information as may be useful.
