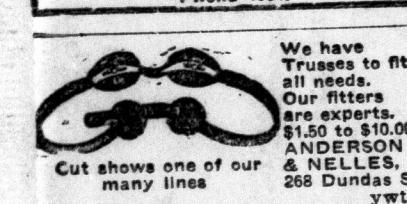

French Fear New Party Will Involve British in Combat.

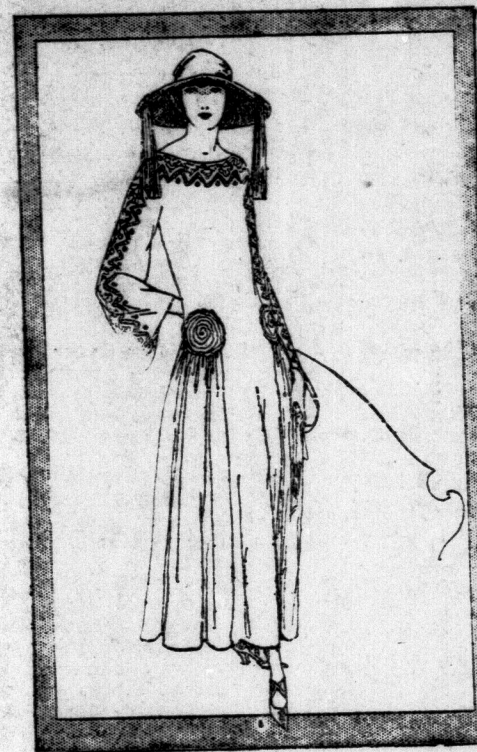

The hatred of Constantine was at least a contributing factor in the French support of Kemal. But one must not suppose that Constantine's going will bring a French pardon for the mistakes they consider the Greek's mistakes, for they recall that an enormous majority of the Greek people voted to bring Constantine back and that his return to the throne was by no means forced upon them. Therefore, the return of ex-Premier Venizelos or his supporters to power would not bring French support for the retention of Thrace by the Greeks.
