CATTLE MARKET.

There was not much change. Receipts were moderately large, there being \$8 loads, 10 of which were fresh. These included about 750 cattle, 20 hogs, 210 sheep and lambs, 12 calves. Cattle — There was a big run of cattle, but quality was generally inferior. Buyers held that sellers were asking equal to the value of choice animals for medium. This had a minimizing effect on business. Really choice butchers' cattelwere firm, picked lots selling at 334c to 600 stuff sold by the load at 34c to 39gc; inferior loads were taken at 3c to 34c; inferior bulls and cows sold down to 24c to 24c. A good deal was taken through to Montreal and the market was pretty well cleaned out in consequence; prospects for Maydelivery of cattle are not good and drivers are talking of 4c to 44c a pound for export.

Hogs—Demand was moderately good and prices were firmer. Prospects are improving. Prices ranged from \$4.50 a hundred fed and watered; sows and rough fat sold at \$4.50 and good fat animals, weighing 160 to 220 pounds, at \$4.35 to \$4.50. Quality was not good, mixed lots preponderating.

Sheep and Lambs—There was not much change in values. There were about 50 sheep, and demand was poor and prices easy at 3½c to 4c a pound. Lambs were only in fair demand at 4½c to 5c a pound. pointd. Lamos were only to 5c a pound. Calves—Were not so plentiful and a few more good animals could have been taken care of: those weighing 130 to 200 pounds sold at \$6 to \$8.
