

Of the imported Stallions, Ambition, Wellwood, Newmains and Lochwinnoch are exceptionally good.

AMBITION (3374), 5 years old, a beautiful brown, by Lord Derby 1742, second at Toronto Industrial and at Provincial Exhibition, Ottawa, 1884; a powerful horse, weighing 2,000 lbs.; is noted as a stock horse in the neighborhood. WELLWOOD 4109, 3 yrs. old, third at London and at Toronto as a two-year-old, sire, Baron Renfrew (37); dam, Sally of Wishaw (3102), by Farmer (286); is full of promise; and NEWMAINS (3030), also three years old, has proved himself a splendid young sire; as has LOCHWINNOCH of the same age. Two of the imported Clydesdale mares have foals, and a number of the brood mares, some of them noted prize winners at the leading exhibitions, are carrying foal.
