CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

Two months ago it was predicted that prices of white pine lumber had reached the top notch for the present movement at least. Since that time the situation has steadily grown stronger, a few grades have advanced in price, and there promiges to be witnessed a further appreciation in lumber prices generally. The figurishing condition of the country at large, and of manufacturing enterprises in particular, augurs well for a heavy consumption of lumber during the fall and winter months. This, coupled with the pronounced shortage of stock, is the basis of the present hopeful feeling in respect to the future of lumber. It would seem to be the wisest policy for buyers of lumber to anticipate their wants as far as possible for the balance of the year and place orders on the present basis of values, as a weaker market is extremely improbable. Western Ontario is now furnishing the bulk of the white pine lumber handled in the Saginaw valley, and dealers in that district are still in the market for stock. The demand for large blocks of lumber has this season been so heavy that dealers in car lots have found it extremely difficult to obtain the lumber required to supply their customers. Some Toronto dealers report that they have been compelled to refuse orders for this reason. There will doubtless be much activity in the woods this winter, with large blocks of stock taken out on contract for the purpose of supplying United States dealers.

Hardwood stocks are becoming re duced to a low point, and it is almost surprising that prices have not advanced to a greater extent. As the true situa-
