In reply, I have to inform you that the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of Canada, who therefore regard your Letter, together with its Annex, and this Reply as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on this day's date and shall be terminable in the circumstances envisaged in paragraph 12 of your Letter of the 15th of April, 1964 or by either Government giving not less than four months' notice in writing to the other.
