## PURPOSE

| <p>1. <u>Department of Energy, Mines and Resources Act</u>,<br/>R.S.C. 1970, c.E-6 as amended by S.C. 1980-81-82-83, c106</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Creates Department of Energy, Mines and Resources; provides appointment of Minister and Deputy Minister; sets out Minister's duties generally; provides for annual report to Parliament.</li> <li>- Amendments authorize the Minister to establish new Crown corporations under the <u>Canadian Business Corporations Act (CBCA)</u> or acquire existing CBCA corporations, with energy related objects.</li> </ul>  |
| <p>2. <u>Resources and Technical Surveys Act</u><br/>R.S.C. 1970, c.R-7</p>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Authorizes technical surveys of resources base, especially mineral, and the preparation and dissemination of maps, samples and specimens.</li> <li>- Makes Minister responsible for coordinating, promoting and recommending national policies and programs in respect to energy, mines, minerals, water and other resources.</li> <li>- Authorizes study and research into those resources and their exploration and development.</li> <li>- Authorizes the formulation of plans to conserve, develop and use these resources and to enter agreements to carry them out with other government departments and with the provinces and municipalities.</li> </ul> |
