1. A total Eclipse of the Moon on the 31st of May, when she will rise about sunset, partly Eclipsed : end of the Eclipse, 7h. 50m.

2. A partial Eclipse of the Sun on the 15th June, invisible in New-Brunswick. It will be visible in the South Pacific Ocean.

3. A partial Eclipse of the Sun on the 10th of November, visible only in a small part of the great Southern Ocean.

4. A total Eclipse of the Moon on the 24th November-when she will rise partly eclipsed. Beginning, 5h. 16m.; middle, 7h. 6m.; end, 9h. 2m.

5. A partial Eclipse of the Sun on the 9th of December, begiuning at 3h. 40m. ; greatest obscuration, 4h. 26m, ; end, 5h.— Digits Eclipsed, 2.51 on Sun's Northern limb.
