During the past year the balance of \$1,800.00 has been raised to pay off the mortgage and we are tonight to burn it, and to declare that we owe no man anything but love.

In closing this paper, I may say, that out of the eighty-six charter members, fourteen are still connected with this church. In thirty-nine years there has been expended on church property \$22,500.00.

The Tabernacle Church, while in every sense a Mission Church, has never asked or received one dollar from denominational funds, but has contributed liberally to the work of our denomination, and for the last few years, at the rate of about \$1,000.00 per year.

During the whole history of the church, 39 years, it has had eight pastors, three of whom, the Rev. J. F. Avery, Rev. W. E. Hall, and the Rev. E. T. Miller, have passed over to the great majority.
