presented by a councillor in his place, immediately after the reading of the Minutes, who shall be answerable to the council that they do not contain improper or impertinent matter. All such petitions and papers shall be read by the Clerk when presented.

That the mode of appointing Special or Standing Committees shall be for each Councillor in his place to name one, which shall be written down by the Clerk. Those who have most Voices shall be taken successively until the number agreed on is completed. W. MORRIS, (Signed)
