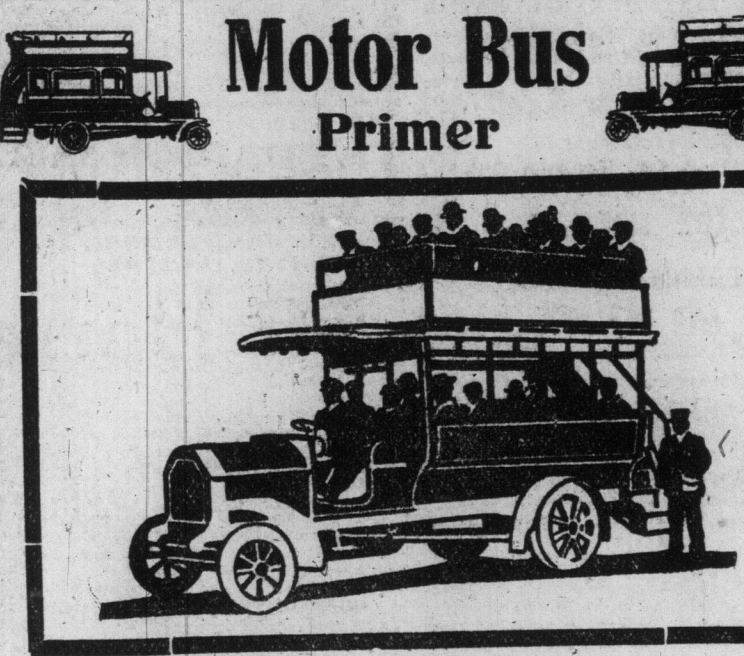

Ninety-Two Head Average \$245.—Some Big Prices.

The entire breeding stock of Edward Corrigan and of his horse in training were sold at the farm, six miles from Lexington, on Wednesday, and much of the stock brought good prices, all conditions considered. Corrigan has also announced that his farm of 500 acres is for sale and that he is out of the racing game for good, except for what stock he owns in the various race tracks in the west and south. Previous to the sale Corrigan sold privately to Major T. J. Carson the two stallions imp. Scudellari and imp. Ormican, which left only two horses to be bid on, Marta Santa and McGee, both imported horses, and the former was the medium of a spirited bidding contest between Charles Hughes, trainer for Puritan, and the Canadian horseman, the former being successful. Ninety-two head sold for an average of \$245.
